<sup>8</sup> Rider 7 & under. Leader 18 & over. Rider may not enter any other riding class. Participation ribbons; no placings

**Directions from Plainwell-** Go 6 miles East on M-89 from Plainwell. Turn North on Doster Rd for 6 miles.

Or in Plainwell go north on Main st, East on Marsh Rd 7 miles , right on Graham, Left on Pine Lake Rd.

**Directions from Richland-** From the corner of M-89 & M-43 (at the Black Hawk Inn), go 6 miles West on M-89. Turn North on Doster Rd for 6 miles.

**Directions from Delton-** From M-43, go West on Delton Rd 3 miles, turn right on Norris Rd for 1 mile, turn left (West) on Pine Lake Rd for 3 miles.
